**1% Sales Purpose Local Option Sales Tax**  
(Vote for One)

“Shall a special one percent sales and use tax be imposed in Oconee County for a period of time not to exceed six consecutive years and for the raising of an estimated amount of \$90,434,289.00 for the purposes of (1) funding for Oconee County (a) the payment of general obligation debt on recreational facilities; (b) the payment of general obligation debt on the Administrative Building and (c) water and sewer facilities; farmland protection; emergency services facilities and equipment; historic and scenic facilities; general county facilities; recreational and park facilities; radio system; and law enforcement vehicles; (2) funding for the City of Watkinsville public safety facilities and equipment; recreational, park and greenspace facilities; transportation and infrastructure facilities; and City facilities, signage and equipment; (3) funding for the Town of Bogart for public safety facilities; recreational and park facilities and general city facilities; (4) funding for the Town of North High Shoals recreational, park and greenspace facilities; roads, streets and bridges; a community building; fire station equipment; greenway facilities and Jefferson Road and Town Park drainage; and (5) funding for the Town of Bishop recreational and park facilities property renovations?”
